Become a CalCPA Campus Ambassador.

Campus Ambassadors are students passionate about pursuing an accounting career and becoming CPAs. Ambassadors display strong leadership and organizational skills, the ability to connect with peers and share their enthusiasm for CalCPA and the CPA profession.

Campus Ambassadors will be responsible for approximately 20 hours of work per semester to achieve three primary objectives:

- · Building awareness of FREE CalCPA student membership benefits to students and educators on their campus.
- Increasing the visibility of CalCPA on your campus.
- Strengthening ties between local CalCPA chapters and your school.

Campus Ambassadors will receive a monetary stipend each semester and free admittance to CalCPA chapter events. Additionally, Campus Ambassadors will be featured on CalCPA's website and will have the opportunity to meet with professional mentors from their local chapter.

ELIGIBILITY

- Attending an accredited college/university in California:
- Sophomore or junior (expected graduation date December 2014 or later) with declared business, economics or finance major or minor, and the intention of pursuing a CPA license.
- 3.0 GPA or above in all major related courses.
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident of the United States.

Applicants must submit a completed application form, unofficial transcript(s) and one essay of up to 500 words for the following question:

1. CalCPA Campus Ambassadors will represent CalCPA on campus. Please explain what you think the value of CalCPA membership is for students and educators.

It is recommended that applicants also submit one letter of recommendation from an accounting or business professor, or finance club adviser.
