Qualifications:

- Students must be an **Economics** or **Economics & Accounting** major, with at least 2 completed upper-division major courses
- Students must have a **minimum UD major GPA of 3.0**
- Students must have a **3.0 GPA in the preceding 3 quarters**
- Students must attend **all 5** of the following **Fridays** from **2:00 PM – 4:00 PM**:
 - **Oct 19, Oct 26, Nov 2, Nov 9, Nov 16**
- Students will receive one unit of ECON 199RA credit if the above is completed

- **Personal statement** explaining your interest in doing economics research (500-word max).
